Pratt Fine Arts Center is pleased to present ***New Voices***, a group exhibition featuring a selection of work from Pratt's Scholarship Program. The artists present new work in printmaking, painting, drawing, bronze casting, glassblowing, frameworking, glass casting and mixed media.
